

**NORTH CENTRE TOWNSHIP
COLUMBIA COUNTY, PA
ORDINANCE 2017-01**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN UNNUMBERED ORDINANCE FROM 1968 WHICH IMPOSED A PER CAPITA TAX OF \$2.00 PER ANNUM ON EACH RESIDENT OF NORTH CENTRE TOWNSHIP 21 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER BEGINNING IN 1969, AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECITON OF THAT TAX.

WHEREAS, the County of Columbia has decided to stop the levy and collection of their Per Capita Tax and,

WHEREAS, the Township would be required to pick up all costs involved in printing and collection of the Township Per Capita Tax due to Columbia County's decision and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of North Centre Township deem it to be in the best financial interest of North Centre Township,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED, by the Township of North Centre, County of Columbia, Pennsylvania:

That the above referenced unnumbered Ordinance from 1968 of North Centre Township and any Resolution or Amendment enacted there-under authorizing the levying and collection of a \$2.00 Per Capita Tax is hereby repealed.

This ordinance is effective upon enactment.
