The meeting was paused at 8:50 PM to conduct a hearing for public comment on the Cable Franchise Renewal.

The hearing ended at 9:01 PM, and the meeting resumed.

Police Report

Officer Emmanuel reported there were 41 calls answered, 26 incidents investigated, 4 magistrate hearing attended, 2 traffic accidents investigated, 7 traffic citations issued, 11 traffic warnings issued, and 4 criminal arrests made.

Zoning Report

The Zoning Report was presented by Supervisor LeVan. There were three zoning permits, and three building permits issued.
